Category 2: Kitchen

- We worked with our engineer to design a bulkhead that contained the new structural beam, included pot-lighting and continued to the exterior wall to integrate with the rest of the living space.
- We also built 48" high partition walls to allow for some separation between the kitchen and living room. This gave us a backsplash behind the cabinets to not only hide cooking mess and small appliances from the view of the front door, but allowed the addition of a slate tiled backsplash to introduce some natural texture to the space.
- We removed the old flooring down to the subfloor and ensured that the new hardwood would be the same level.
- We selected the same species of wood and included a 5" wide band between the new and old floors to visually separate the kitchen and dining room.
- The new kitchen is clean, modern and in keeping with the 1960's style of the house, just what the homeowners were looking for.
