Category 2: Kitchen

- The structural addition to the house provided the necessary square footage to make some significant changes within the interior.
- On one side of the old kitchen, the wall that defined the boundary between the kitchen and dining room has been replaced with a long Salem Maple wood peninsula stained in Weatherstone Slate and topped with Cashmere White granite that provides a furniture-like module that does double-duty in both kitchen and dining room.
- In the kitchen, Shaker-style Dartmouth cabinets of MDF construction are painted with an antique off-white.
- The wall on the kitchen side of the staircase was removed and replaced with a spindle railing.
